AOB – Next Season

Thank you for your attendance tonight; your support throughout the season and welcome to all our new clubs.

After last year's AGM we ran a survey throughout this season to collect feedback from our members to improve our league.

Our actions tonight and throughout the season are a direct response to your feedback.

Communication Score = 3.8/10 (Poor)

RDYFL Actions –

- *We have developed newsletters – our intention was monthly, however content wise this proved difficult – proposal is to go quarterly with some content provided by clubs and players*
- *We have developed a communication policy for you to take away tonight and this will be uploaded onto the website as a PDF*
- *We are stepping up our recruitment and have created a guide to the RDYFL; a draft of which is for you to take this evening*
- *More updates of information through the website, twitter and Facebook*
- *More committee members to share some of the workload*
- *Invitation to ALL team managers to attend meetings rather than just secretaries with options for Q&A at the end*

Website Usefulness Score = 6/10 (Good)

RDYFL Actions –

- *More updates of the website with key information and notices*
- *Using twitter and Facebook to share more updates*

Results and Fixtures Score = 5.42/10 (Effective)

RDYFL Actions –

- *Have installed two more fixtures secretaries to share around some of the workload*
- *Devolved fixtures into three categories: Mini-Soccer; U11-U14s and U15s-U18s*
- *Moving the results system to the 'online submission' using Full-Time, thus removing the responsibility from the results secretary and then given to managers (details to be given out in the August meeting)*
- *Responsibility for rearrangement of fixtures has been returned to fixtures secretaries not individual managers to arrange*
- *Teams will be instantly charged for a postponement and will have to respond with an explanation to the relevant fixtures secretary*

Referees Score = 6.42/10 (Good)

NOTE: Performances of referees were (on the whole) very good last season. Issues arose with the allocation and availability of referees

RDYFL Actions –

- *New referees secretary installed with more experience and contacts in the game*
- *Work with DFA Referees' Development Officer to improve recruitment, retainment and allocation of referees*
- *RDYFL propose to run our own referees' course in 2017*

Mini-Soccer Score = 6.75/10 (Good)

NOTE: as in previous years, the respondents asked for all weather or 3G surfaces for use by the league in bad weather. RDYFL are working with DFA to secure a location, however nowhere has been secured yet.

RDYFL Actions –

- *Have introduced a fourth centre (Hasland Park) to accommodate a further influx of teams*
- *Added a second fixtures secretary to absorb some of the workload*
- *New goals and equipment have been purchased*
- *Respect barriers WILL be available at ALL centres for the start of 2016/17 season*
- *Discussions underway about Mini-Soccer Sundays*

Fustal
