

Note to cup final teams – arrangements

To team managers

Details of the cup final dates have been sent to Club Secretaries and have been posted on the League website. This note is to remind team managers of a few points they will need to bear in mind for the finals:

1. Teams should arrive for their final 30 minutes before their kick off, and report to League Management officials when they arrive at the ground.
2. Teams MUST bring their player i/d cards with them. I/D cards will be checked by League officials and any player not having an I/D card will not be allowed to play.
3. Each team must bring with team at least one match ball each for which they are responsible.
4. The League will provide the match referee and linesmen.
5. Please check with your opposition and make arrangements to ensure there is no clash of colours with your strip.
6. An entry fee of £2 will be charged for entry to the ground for adults. Children aged under 16 years will be free. Team players, the team manager and one assistant team manager will have free entry.
7. Intoxicating liquor or beer etc is NOT allowed to be brought into the ground. (this doesn't cover celebratory 'bubbly'). Drinks and beverages etc can be bought inside the ground.
8. There is no car parking inside the ground for those teams playing at Matlock FC. Additionally because of reconstruction works those teams playing at Matlock FC there will be no changing rooms and players should come ready changed in their playing strip.
9. The League will be providing individual players medals for the winners and runners up – 14 per team for under 7s to U10s; and 16 per team for U11s to U18s. If teams wish to purchase additional player medals please contact Hellison's Trophies, Matlock.
10. A programme for each cup final will be produced and will be available at the finals.
