How will it be addressed?

- New referees secretary (hopefully two)
- Training workshop for new committee members
- Closer work with DFA and possibly Chesterfield Referee's Association
- RDYFL to run our own refereeing courses in 2017?
- RDYFL will send out referee registration forms before the end of March 2016

Fixtures

- Mini-Soccer will run on Saturdays
- U11s, U12s **and U13s** will run on **BOTH** Saturday and Sunday
- U14s – U18s Sunday ONLY
- Three fixtures secretaries with responsibility for four age groups each

Intended outcomes:

- Better communication
- More fixtures
- Quicker updating of the website
- Control of postponements/rearranged games

Results

AIM: Introduce the 'text in' system and evaluate similar systems operated by other leagues

WHEN: 2016/17 season – will be set up for the August meeting with training from DFA

Intended outcomes:

- Increased responsibility for managers
- Quicker publication of results
- Decrease in workload for fixtures secretary
- Website up-to-date and accurate

Mini-Soccer

- Respect barriers will be in place at all three venues for the start of the 2016/17 season
- Our intention is to run a fourth centre from September 2016
- (Ideally) this will be a 3G facility: MH and GE met with representatives from DFA to assist with the negotiation of such a facility
- Fees will rise to £20 per game per team next season to subsidise this (should this become a reality)

Trophies

- All trophies and shields should be returned by the end of this meeting
- IF there are any still outstanding, can you return them as soon as possible to Andy Bagshaw please

Registrations

Stage 1: 14th June 2016 – 30th June 2016

- NO LOGIN IS REQUIRED TO ENTER STAGE 1 – ONLY CLUB SECRETARIES SHOULD ENTER THIS INFORMATION
- For existing and new clubs whose teams wish to play in the Rowsley & District Youth Football League during the 2016-17 season, the club Secretary is required to register ELECTRONICALLY on the RDYFL website , including club officer contact information and an indication by age group of the number of teams they wish to enter for Season 2016-17
- For example: ABC Wanderers FC U7 x 2; U11x 1; U8x 2; U12x 1; U9x1; U10x 1 etc.
- New Team Details, Leagues will not show on the RDYFL website Club Directory and Team Directory until the full league constitution is created in July.
- Nothing else is required at this stage, no managers names – no team addresses – no team pitches – no team contact details – JUST NUMBER OF TEAMS BY AGE GROUP.

THIS MUST BE COMPLETED BY 30th JUNE 2016

Registrations

Registration Stage 2: 1st July 2016 to 15th July 2016

- From 1st July 2016 to 15th July 2016 Secretaries must login FIRST to their control panel on the RDYFL site, which will generate the new teams (Managers you cannot log in to your team until your club Secretary has done this!)
- Secretaries are then required to ensure that all managers have registered a login for the RDYFL site and have logged in and added the relevant team contact information before the 15th July 2016. Subsequent changes/updates can also be made.
- **THE NEW CLUB/TEAM INFORMATION WILL NOT SHOW ON THE WEBSITE FOR THE 2016/17 SEASON UNTIL THE CONSTITUTION OF DIVISIONS HAS BEEN CREATED BY THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**
- **ANY CLUB/TEAM NOT COMPLETING THE ABOVE REGISTRATION PROCESS BY THE DEADLINES SHOWN WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO COMPETE IN THE RDYFL FOR THE 2016/17 SEASON**
